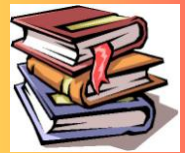
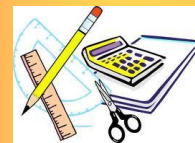
★Summer weather is upon us.. so we will be taking advantage of the nice evenings and doing more activities outside. These may include water games!
